Based in Leominster, About Face is one of just a handful of professional theatre companies in the UK to employ only actors with learning disabilities.

Previous productions include The Raven and the Sun (1997), Comus (in collaboration with Pentabus Theatre Company, performed at Ludlow Castle in 1998), The Dream Machine (1999), The WaveWatchers (schools tour 2001), The Cutters (site specific installation show 2003), The Red Dress (2004) and Undercurrents (workshop and performances touring schools Spring 2005).
